**Purpose of meeting:** Discussion and Possible Action on Decision to Place a Kayak Kiosk at Boat Landing on Lake Marinuka

**Items Discussed:** Mr. Flood's proposed Kiosk would offer 4 Kayaks and 4 Paddle Boards at the Kiosk to be set up near the Skate Shelter at the boat landing with the exact location to be determined with Public Works Director, Mr. Peterson

Mr. Flood will handle all concerns with the operation of the Kiosk. City will arrange a one year lease for the Kiosk to be placed at the boat landing.

The city will charge no fee for this first year to support the start up of this new business. Mr. Flood offered a 5% donation of proceeds to the charity of the City's choice. Committee offered the Lake District as the possible recipient.

**Recommendations to the Council:** The Committee recommends the Council proceed with Approval of the placement of a Kayak Kiosk at the boat landing on Lake Marinuka and direct our City Attorney to draft a one-year lease between The City and Mr. Flood.

**Budget and Tax Impacts:** None, Mr. Flood will be responsible for all costs of the Kiosk.
