- Storm Water drainage concerns on Campus Court: Mayor Thatcher and DPW Director continue looking for someone who might be able to provide insight on possible fixes for drainage problems.
- Illumination of US Flag on the Gazebo in the downtown square: Sounds as if the Lions Club may be taking this on as a project. No action taken.
- Pedestrian Safety Enhancements in downtown area: Chair Carlson will reach out to Wisconsin Department of Transportation to discuss and bring this back for a future meeting.
- Winter parking regulations: Current “odd/even” restrictions and possible alternatives were discussed, but no action was taken.
