Meeting was called to order by Chair Dave Carlson at 4:00 p.m.

Carlson certified that Open Meetings requirements were met for this meeting.

Motion by Larson, second by Redsten to approve minutes of August 7, 2024 Streets and Sidewalks meeting. Motion approved.

Discussion of storm water drainage problems on Campus Court:

Todd Pederson indicated that a review of the street by Nelson Excavating indicated that three culverts are slanted the wrong way and that they should need to be repositioned and lowered. Problem was verified by Davy Engineering. Possible fixes will continue to be researched and the issue will be discussed again at the October Streets and Sidewalks meeting.

Retaining Wall Replacement on West Ridge Avenue:

Jim Lundberg from Point of Beginning Engineering (POB) clarified for the Committee that the next steps in the process, if we choose to proceed, would be to create final engineered construction documents and prepare applications for permits needed for the project. These are Tasks D and E on the contact agreement between POB and the City of Galesville. Motion by Redsten, seconded by Larson to recommend to Council that we proceed with Task D at a cost of \$9,750 and Task E at a cost of \$500. Motion approved.

Designation of additional ATV/UTV routes in the City of Galesville:

No action taken. Item will be placed on October agenda for further discussion.

Update on Winter Parking Regulations: No action taken.

Flowers and Banners in downtown area: No action taken

Consideration of 2025 Budget Requests: No action taken. Committee will consider requests at October meeting.
