

Monthly meeting for Streets and Sidewalks on Feb 7, 2024:

Called to order at 4pm

Purpose of the meeting:

Review - West Ridge Avenue sidewalk project progress. Todd reported boring to be completed this week or next.

Update the committee that the Code of Violation letter for the feral cats does not need a resolution.

Notice that the code violation letter and the street light process has been placed on the city's website.

Todd provided an application from the DOT for the crosswalk request near High Cliff Park.

Alternate side parking changes have been tabled until June 2024.

2-hour parking in downtown Galesville discussed. Recommendation to remove 2-hour parking downtown was made by Carlson, second made by Wallner and motion carried with all in favor vote.

Main street parking -The removal of 3 parking spaces for safety reasons was discussed. Motion by Carlson to have a safety study completed prior to deciding this parking issue. Seconded by Wallner and motion carried.

RRFB (pedestrian safety lights) for downtown – Diane reported awaiting written information from the DOT office regarding the process required for these lights.

Downtown Sidewalk repair project – Todd provided the committee with a map of the sidewalks and estimated cost of repair by Reedy's concrete. A new estimate for the bank sidewalk area was requested.

Recommendations for the Council:

Remove 2-hour parking from downtown.
