## **Finance Committee** July 21, 2022

Kelly Kreger reported that they reviewed and approved the bills. She postponed the review of the Treasurer's Report until next week. They also reviewed the quarterly overtime report and lease payments to the city.

Kelly Kreger made a motion to give \$200.00 to the Chamber of Commerce for the Apple Affair; seconded by Tom Thatcher. Motion carried unanimous roll call vote.

Kelly Kreger made a motion to recommend to accept the bid from Les Manske for approximately \$14,750.00 to repair the walking trail with the funds to come from the Environmental Impact Fund and any overage to come from the General Fund; seconded by Jean Wallner. Motion carried unanimous roll call vote.

Kelly Kreger made a motion to accept Federal Signals quote 61322832 with all 3 of the options included for a total of \$50,875.00 with the funds to come from the ARPA funds; seconded by Tory-Kale Schulz. Motion carried unanimous roll call vote.

Kelly Kreger made a motion to accept the quote from MCS Networks for \$7,908.02 with the funds to come from the ARPA funds, also to accept the quote from West Road Electric for \$629.39 with those funds also coming from ARPA funds. Approximately \$400 will be required for 5 months of internet service to maintain the cameras. We will apply to Zion Lutheran Church for the funds to come from the pledge to the city for Cance Park upgrades that was made; seconded by Linda Skwierawski. Jean Wallner wanted to go on record that she is opposed to the whole idea of cameras. Tory-Kale Schulz questioned how we currently pay MCS Networks for the service they provide. He was concerned about having the church paying for the internet service out of their pledge when it could go for something that could be played on. Motion carried 3:2 (yays) Tom Thatcher, Kelly Kreger, Linda Skwierawski (nays) Jean Wallner, Tory-Kale Schulz
