SEC. 9-5-1 MANDATORY SEWER AND WATER CONNECTION.

- (a) The use of a private sewer and/or water system by premises within the City of Galesville shall be discontinued, and such premises shall be connected to the public sewer and/or water system.
- (b) All abandoned treatment tanks and seepage pits shall have the contents pumped and disposed of in accordance with the provisions of Chapter NR 113, Wis. Adm. Code. The top or entire tank shall be removed and the remaining tank or excavation shall be immediately filled with suitable soil material.
- (c) The Health Officer of the City of Galesville shall investigate violations of this Section and shall issue orders to abate the violations and submit proper orders for enforcement of this Section.
- (d) The Health Officer of the City is authorized and empowered to enter any lands within the City between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to investigate possible violations of this Section.

SEC. 9-5-2 ADDRESS OF WATER/SEWER BILLINGS.

Water and sewer utility bills for rental properties shall be issued to owners of record of the property in question.
