

City of Galesville Ordinance 10-1-28: Alternate Side Parking

The City of Galesville reminds all residents and visitors that the seasonal Alternate Side Parking ordinance is now in effect for the winter season.

Effective Dates: The alternate side parking regulation is in effect from **November 1st** through **March 31st** of the succeeding year.

Parking Regulations (Ordinance 10-1-28):

- **Even Calendar Dates:** Park on the **EVEN-NUMBERED** side of the street.
- **Odd Calendar Dates:** Park on the **ODD-NUMBERED** side of the street.

Note on Calendar Days: "The calendar day" is defined as the current date (even or odd) at **Midnight (12:00 AM)**, continuing for the next 24 hours (consecutive).

Streets with Parking Only on One Side: Where parking is normally permitted only on one side of the street, vehicles shall be parked on that side of the street **every night** of the week.

Purpose: This ordinance is strictly enforced to facilitate snow removal and street maintenance during the winter months, ensuring clear and safe passage for emergency vehicles and the traveling public.

Violations: Vehicles found to be in violation of the Alternate Side Parking Ordinance are subject to ticketing and may be towed at the owner's expense.

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping our streets safe and clear this winter.
